




A little about Enable North Yorkshire

- Possibly one of the biggest disruptions in business in the technology age






- Step change in adoption of video calling in business and at home

- Digitisation of many processes to facilitate home and remote working






Landscape changes

- Virtual whiteboards just don't work as well




Some ideas
